

## Information required for completion of OMP 2011

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A number of provisional assumptions have been made in order to allow some development of OMP 2011 to proceed. Final decisions are however now required for the following:

1. Subsistence (IR):

- i. Total take for the 2010/2011 season.
- ii. Super-area splits of the 2011/2011 subsistence catch.
- iii. Future splits of subsistence catch:  
 These values have provisionally been taken as averaged subsistence take over the last four seasons (excluding 2010/2011):
 

Area 1-2	=	3.3%
Area 3-4	=	20.7%
Area 5-6	=	24.6%
Area 7	=	0.0%
Area 8	=	51.3%

2. Recreational take:

- i. Estimate from telephone survey for 2010/2011.
- ii. Recreational super-area splits of 2010/2011 recreational take.
- iii. Future splits of recreational takes – any changes needed?  
 Current assumptions are:
 

Area 1+2	=	2%
Area 3-4	=	12.5%
Area 5-6	=	12.5%
Area 7	=	4%
Area 8	=	69%

3. Poaching levels:

- i. Past/historic levels of poaching (500, 250 or?)
- ii. Future levels of total poaching
- iii. Future super-area splits of poaching  
 Current assumptions (as used for OMP 2007) are:
 

Area 1+2	=	1%
Area 3-4	=	2.5%
Area 5-6	=	2.5%
Area 7	=	14%
Area 8	=	80%

## 4. Sector splits of global TAC assumed so far for OMP 2011:

Recreational	5%	3% - 6%	250 MT
Subsistence/IR	8.8%	7% - 11%	500 MT

## 5. Rules for over/under catches.

As an opener, the following is put forward to initiate discussion:

- i. Undercatch – no adjustment, used to benefit resource recovery
- ii. Overcatch – subtracted from allocation (to sector or participant in sector as appropriate) two years after the overcatch occurred (as information to make immediate adjustment would not be available sufficiently early).
