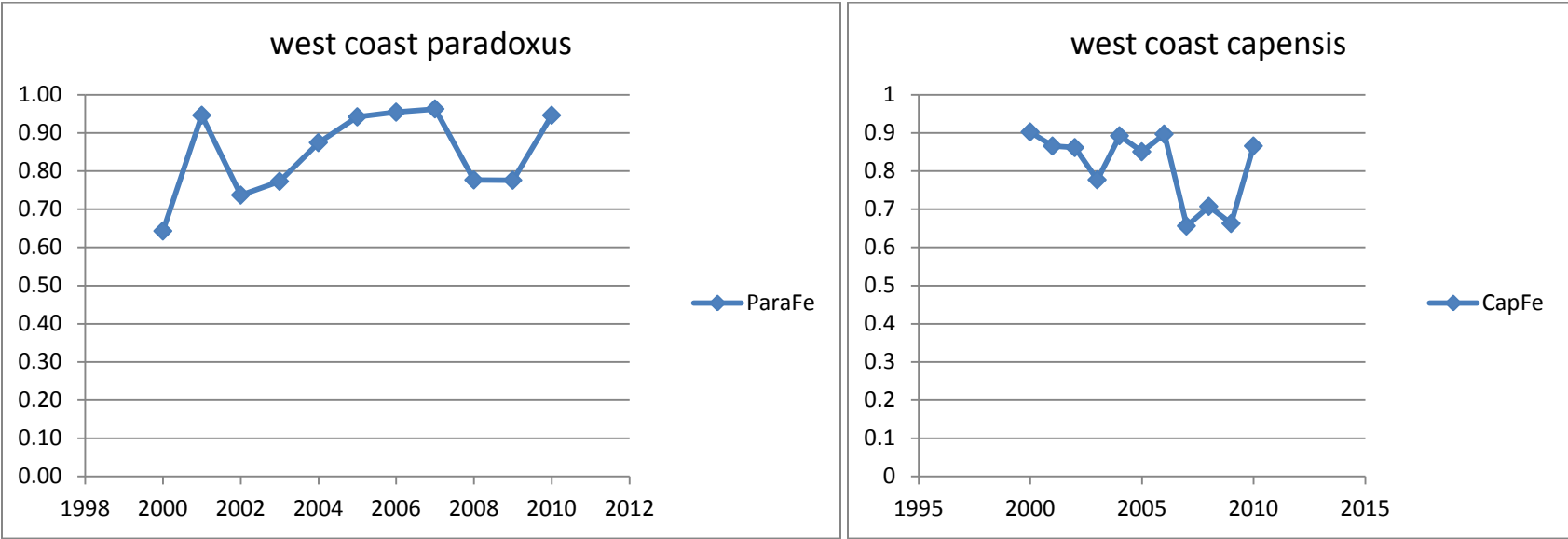
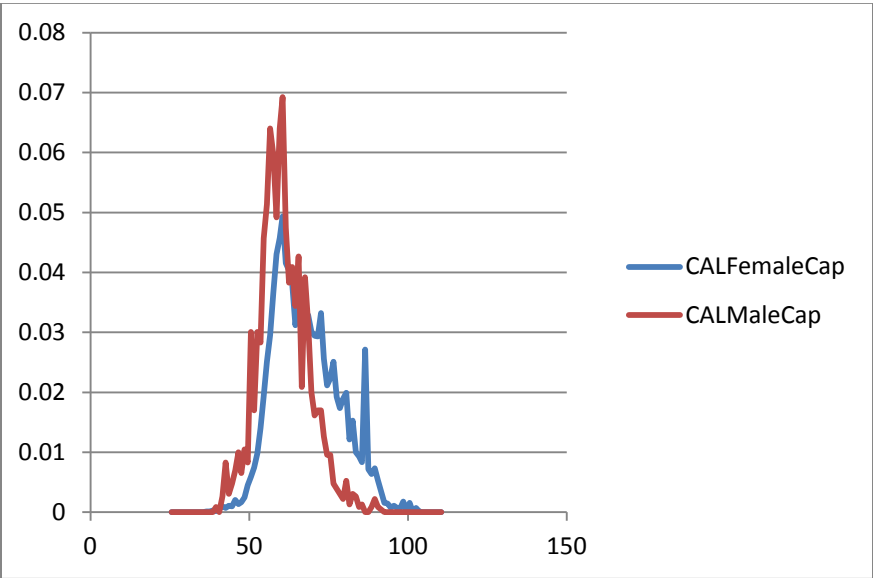
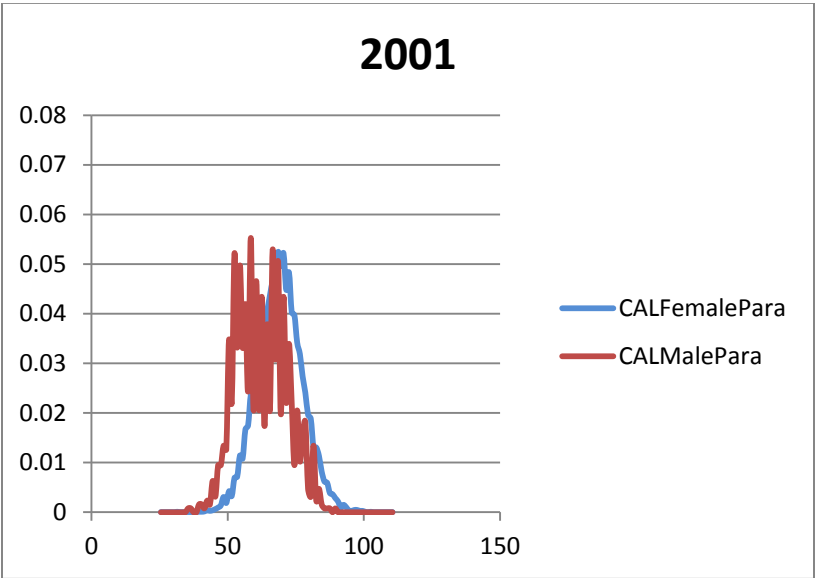
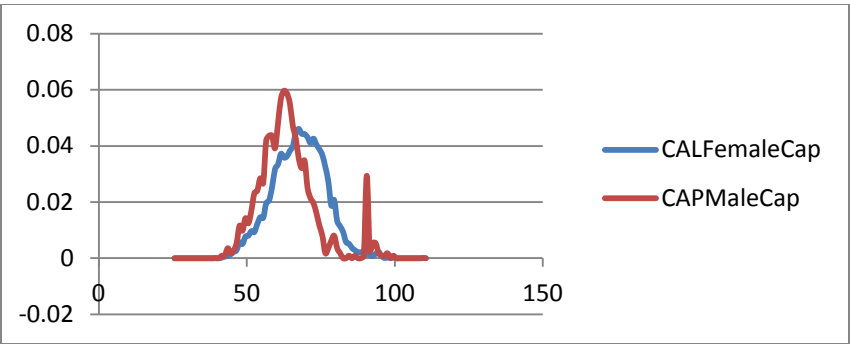
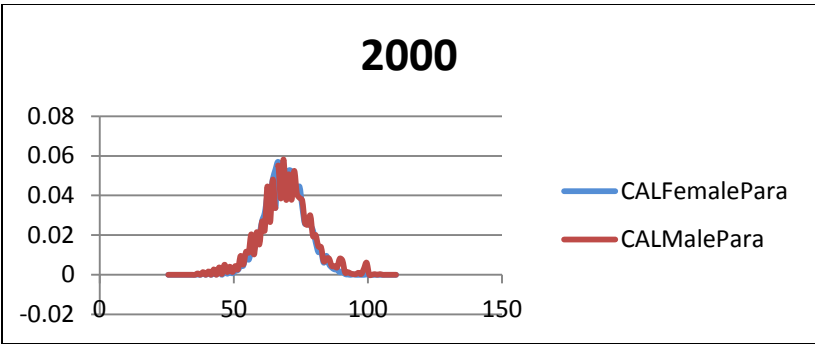
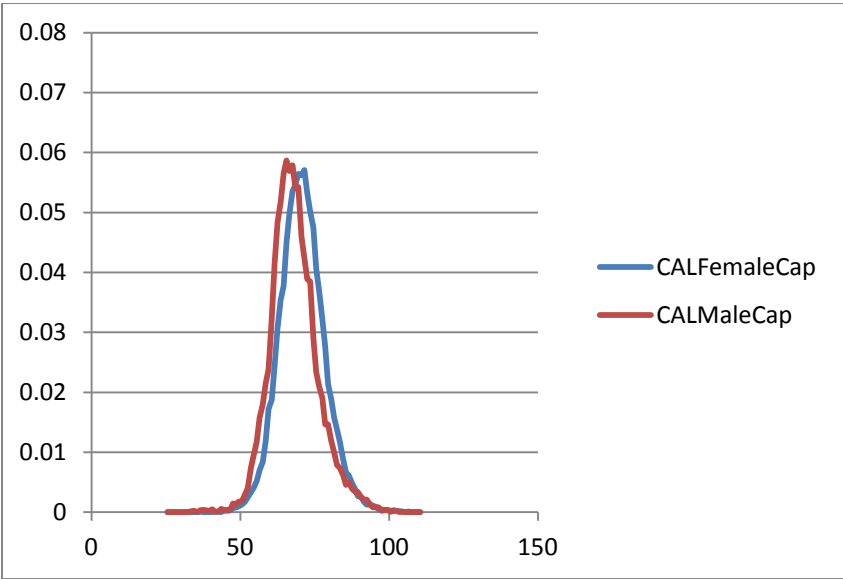
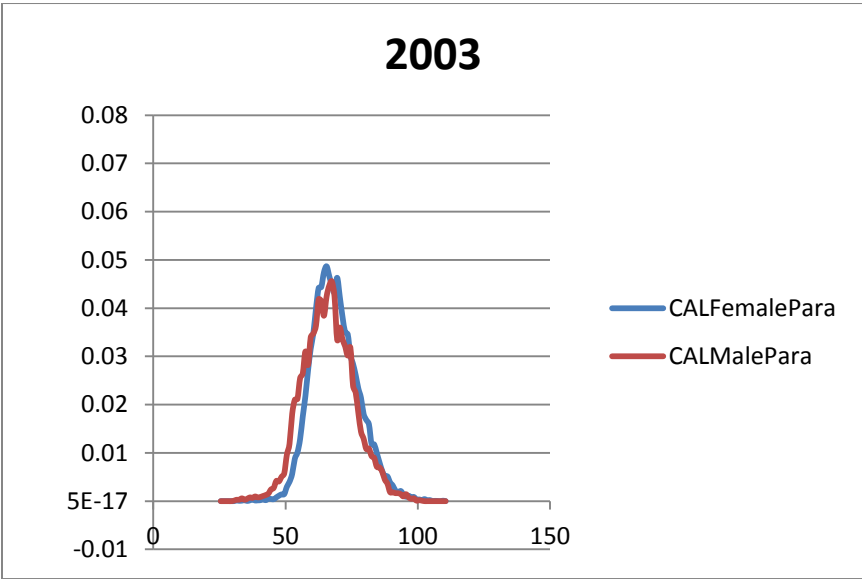
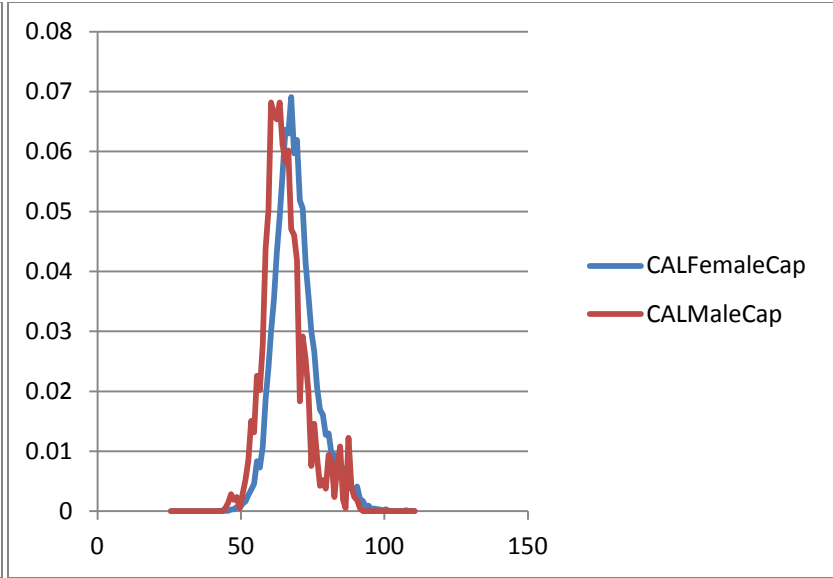
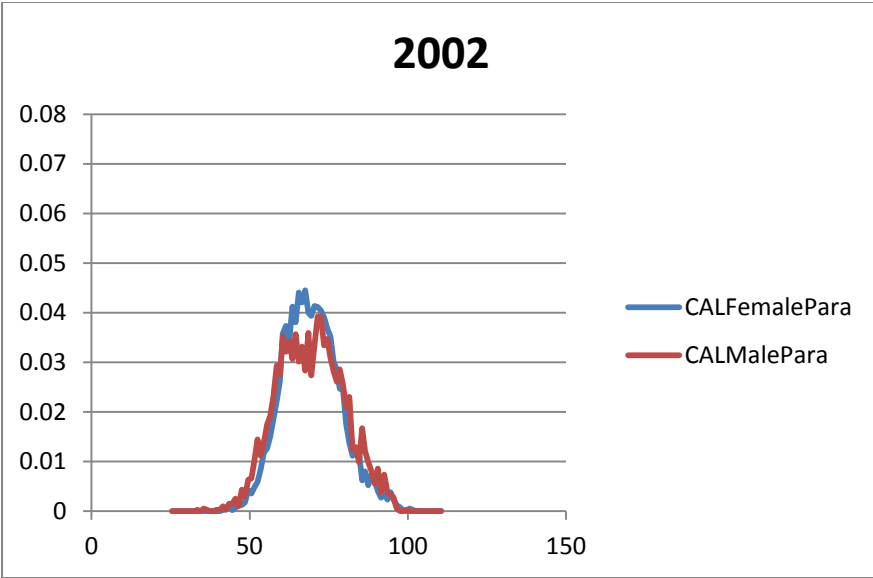
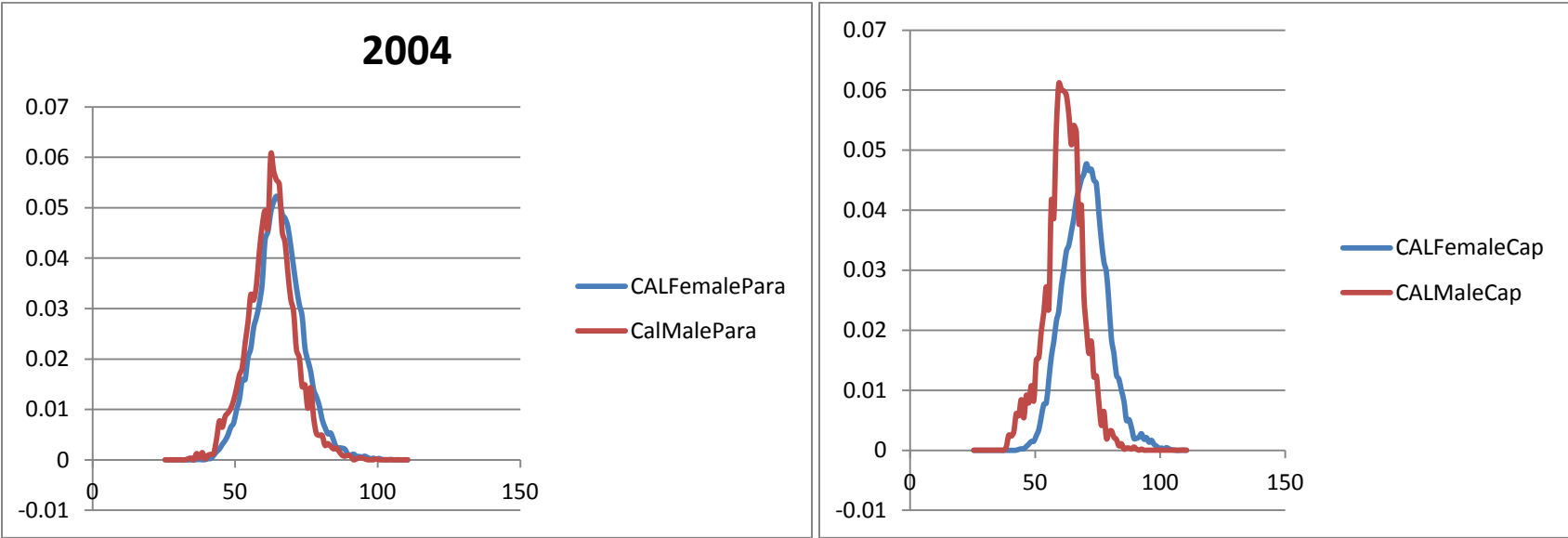


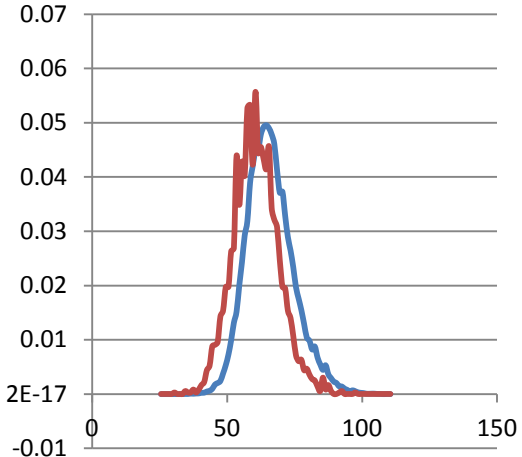
Figure 1: Female proportions of both *M. paradoxus* and *M. capensis* in the west coast



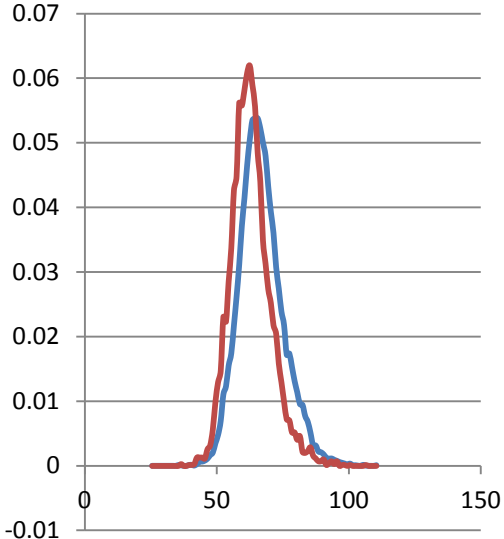




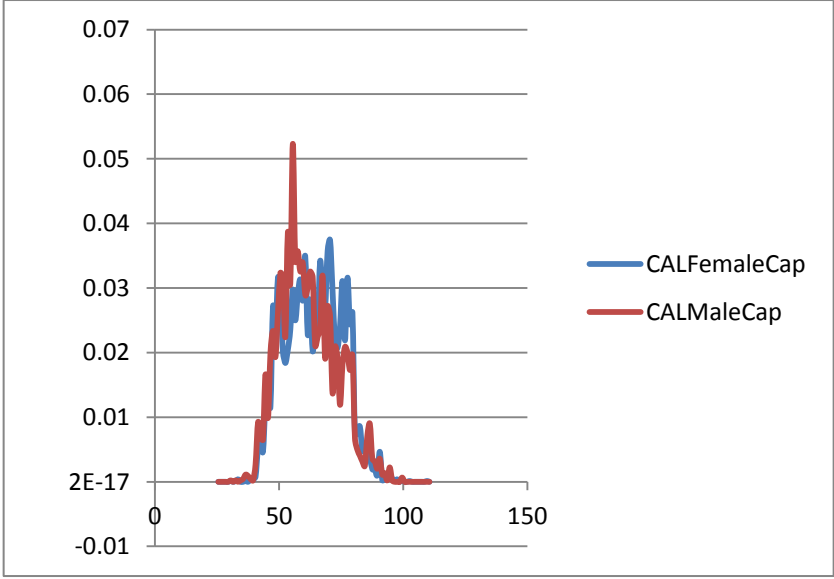
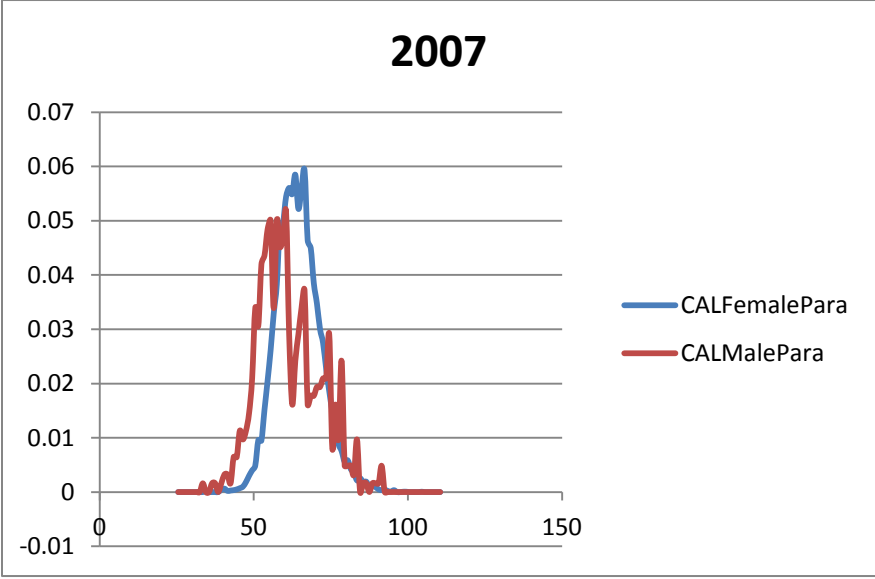
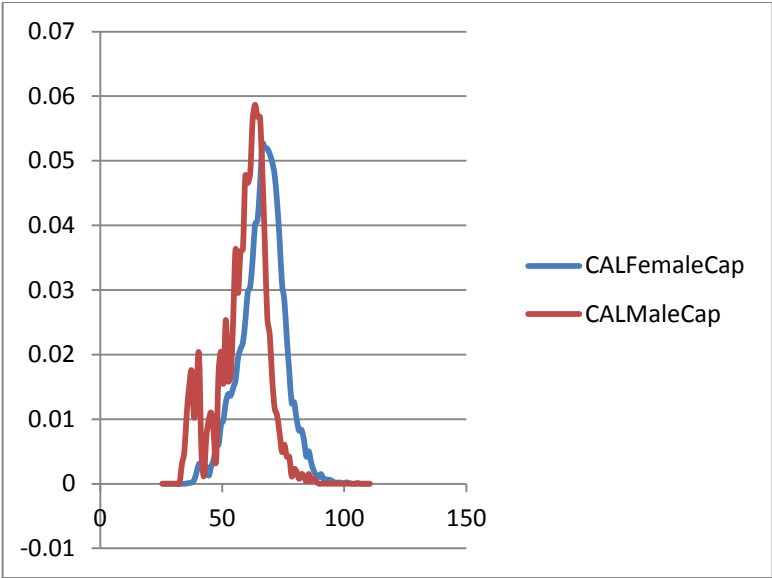
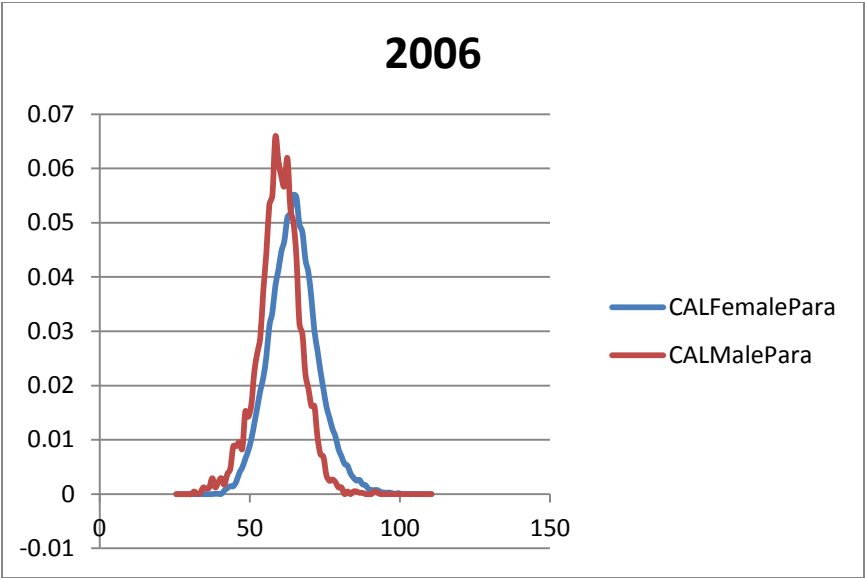

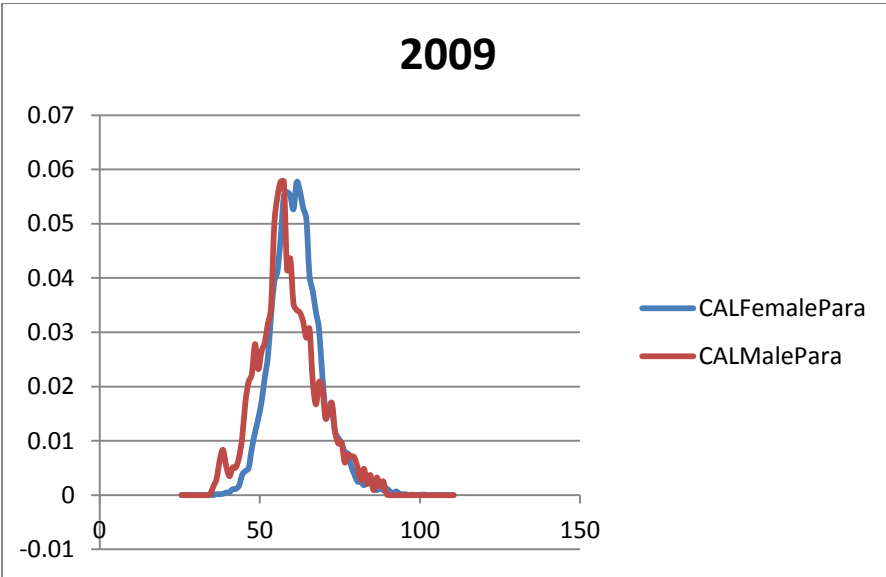
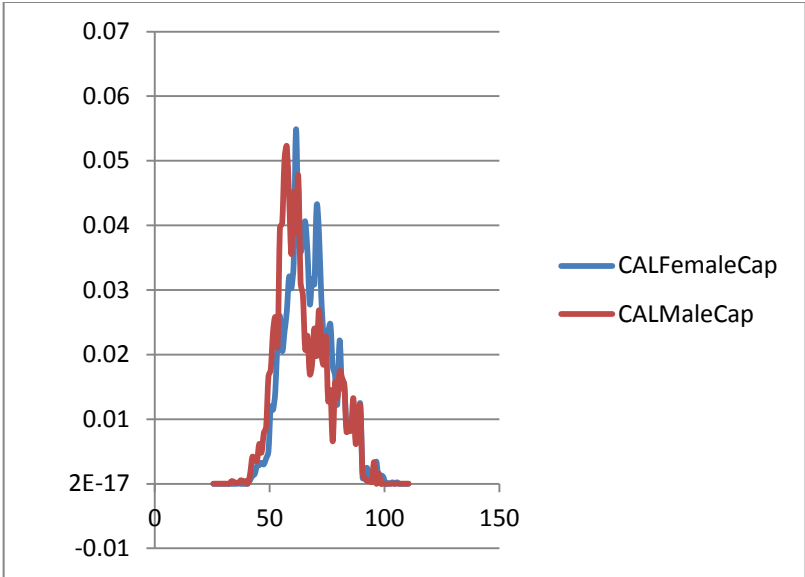
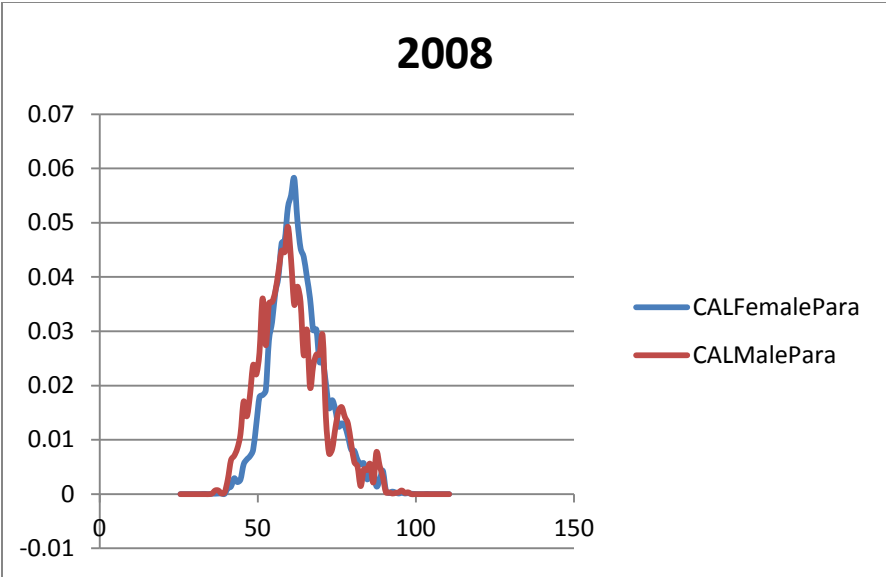

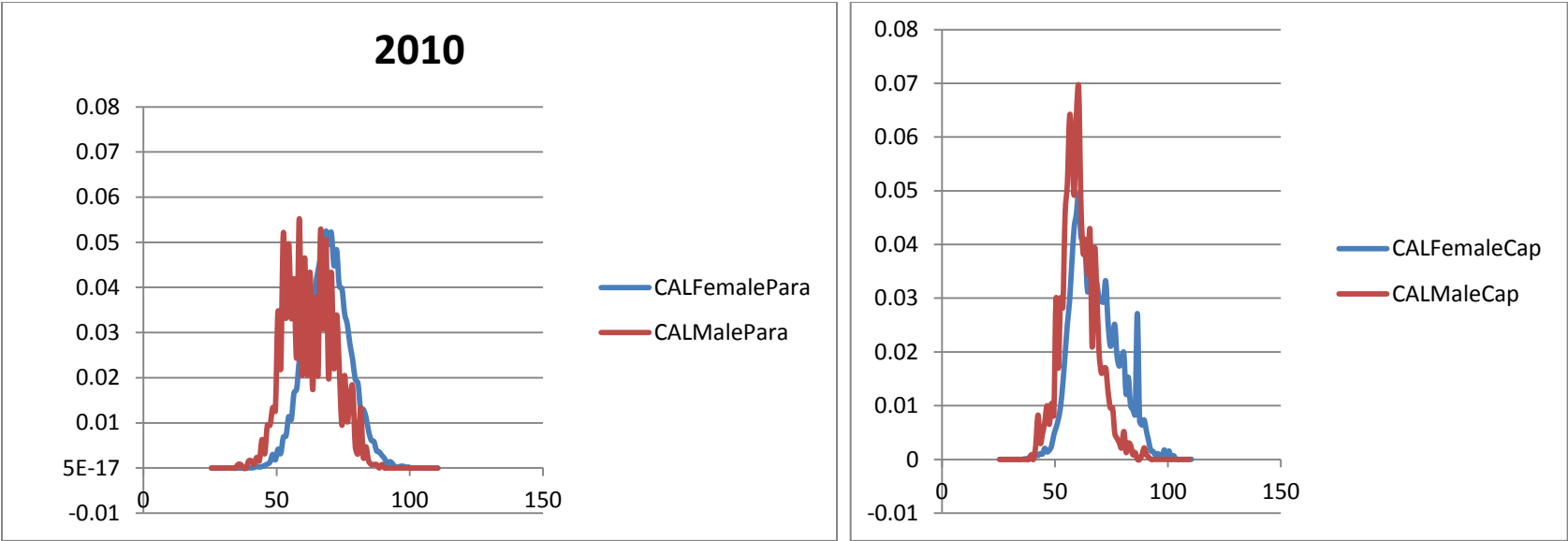


Figure 2: Length distributions of *M. paradoxus* (left panel) and *M. capensis* (right panel) in the west coast.
